Embroidery Pattern: Sushi

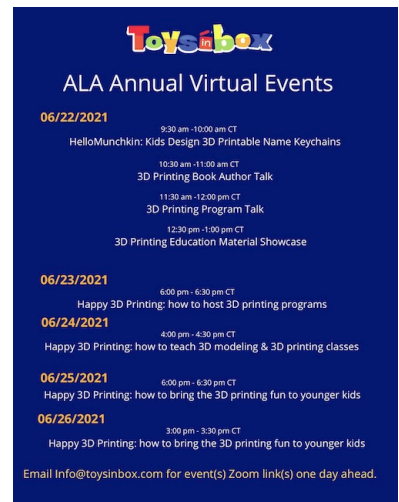

We will launch a new website where anyone can download a keychain with their name for free. Each file will be generated by our HelloMunchkin. It is fully 3D printable and finishes well. Also, the printing time is not long. For us, it takes less than 30 mins to 3D print a name keychain with 0.2mm layer height. If your name is not available, you can request for it to be added.
