Teen Program: Fidget Gyro Spinner

While the students are watching, we will introduce and explain the 3D printing process.

It's pretty fun to fiddle around with it, and it's worth mentioning that the metal ring is the size of a quarter. This information may give you an idea of the size of this fidget gyro spinner.
