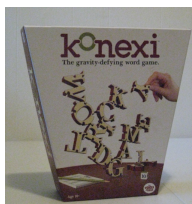
Warren Buffett, Chewing Gum and

Konexi is a fun game to play. It requires a patient and steady hand and a smart mind to survive the round and to win that game. It includes letters A - Z shaped plastic high-quality blocks and each letter has notches in certain places and tabs sticking out on the side of the letter. You connect the letters to create a tower. If you create a word, you earn points. The number of points equals the number of letters in the word you just created. If you knock down the tower, there is a three point penalty. 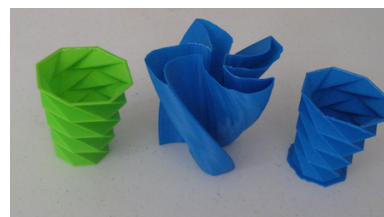
is a fun game to play and I recommend that someday you should play it.

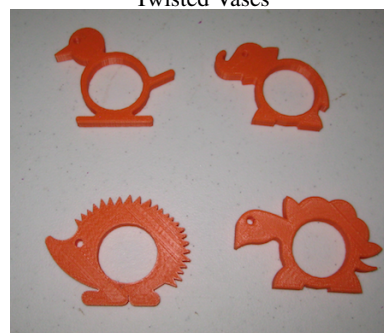
