Glazed Lemon Squares

In this Fun Things to Do issue, we will learn how to make Glazed Lemon Squares! I made some for my school project and everybody loved them. Let's start.

Bake the Lemon Squares

Ingredients:

- 1. $\frac{3}{4}$ cup melted butter
- 2. $1\frac{1}{4}$ cup sugar (granulated white)
- 3. 1 egg
- 4. 1 tsp lemon juice
- 5. 1 tsp lemon extract
- 6. $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp salt
- 7. $\frac{1}{2}$ baking powder
- 8. 2 cup flour

Cream butter and sugar until smooth. Whisk the egg into the butter and sugar. Blend until smooth. Add in the lemon juice extract and continue to blend. Sift the salt, baking powder, and flour. Mixing $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of

the flour into the batter at a time. Mix the batter until the texture is of cookie dough. Oil a 9 x9 inch pan. Then fill with the batter. Bake the batter at $350^{\circ}F$ for 15 minutes or until firm.

Glaze the Lemon Squares

Glaze:

- 1. $\frac{1}{4}$ cup sugar (granulated white)
- 2. $1\frac{1}{2}$ tbsp lemon juice
- 3. 1 tsp lemon extract
- 4. 1 tpsp milk
- 5. $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp Vanilla extract

Whisk together the liquid ingredients until throughly combined. Whisk in the sugar until the sugar crystals have dissolved. Spread the glaze over the lemon squares with a baking brush. Cut into 16 squares and serve warm. Enjoy!
